CALL FOR ARTISTS - ARTISTIC RESIDENCY

Where ?

- Matera - Basilicata (European Capital of Culture 2019)

Looking for:

- Groups of artists or single artists from any artistic sector including scientific culture, innovation and digital communication.
- Projects that imply the involvement of local communities respecting the values of the Matera 2019 project and confronting a need or a desire of the local population.

Objectives:

- Getting involved the citizens living on the outskirts of the city
- Develop the international component of the program Matera 2019
- Encourage local actors of cultures and citizens to open themselves to the European artistic reality
- "Rebalance" the artistic sectors not covered or only partially covered by the dossier (photography, comics, literature, jazz, artistic handicrafts, etc.).

The residency must necessarily provide and generate: -

- active participation of the host community through meetings, workshops, collective actions, involvement and engagement actions; -
- a final output, material or immaterial, generated by the artist or performer with the substantial contribution of the community



Duration

- From 2 to 12 weeks, also in more than one step.

Budget

The Foundation provides a contribution up to a maximum of € 10,000 for each residency project. In the event that the total cost of the residence is higher than this amount, the amount exceeding the contribution of the Foundation remains the responsibility of the implementing entity. Projects in co-financing and / or with financial support from project partners will be favored. The following costs are eligible for financing:

- Compensation of the artist / artists
- Travel, board and lodging of the artist / artists
- Materials necessary for the laboratories and the realization of the final output
- Possible remuneration of a residency organizer.
